Evington Community Association is sponsoring a project to prepare materials and submit to the Campbell County Board of Supervisors for a Resolution supporting designation of Route 24 from its intersection with US29, westward to the Bedford County line, a 'Virginia Byway'. This program is being coordinated with Bedford County to include that continuing westward portion of Route 24 to its intersection with Route 43. At its August 8th meeting, the Bedford Board of Supervisors approved continuing with the program.
